



## Fair Play Point System

- Points are kept for each team for the entire sports season and added together at the end.
- These points should not determine a student’s actual grade in the class, although individual student grading can reflect some of the lesson objectives.
- Teachers should not feel obligated to use all options and should prioritize focus areas for the season.
- Teacher discretion should be used for the number of points that are awarded or subtracted for each opportunity.

## Suggested Options for Points

Point Opportunities	Point Range	Points Awarded By
Arriving on time and prepared to practice/play (entire team)	1-3	Teacher
Fulfilling team role responsibilities	See Rubric	Teacher
Contracts signed properly	1-5	Teacher
Participation in warm-ups and/or practices (entire team)	1-5	Teacher
Supporting and encouraging teammates	1-5	Teacher or Student
Supporting and encouraging other teams or officials	1-5	Student
Fulfilling role as Duty Team (when applicable)	1-5	Teacher or Captain
Demonstrating fair play during practices/games	1-5	Teacher or Student
Completion of Homework	1-5	Teacher
Scaled points for winning teams for each instant activity	1-6	Teacher
Winning team during a match or game	3	Official
Tying team during a match	2	Official
Losing team identifies areas of improvement after a match	1	Coach or Sport Psychologist
Point Reductions	Points Subtracted	Points Reduced By
Arguing with calls of officials	1-5 (each instance)	Teacher or Student
Not working with teammates/creating conflict	1-5 (each instance)	Teacher or Student
Disrespecting equipment or space	1-5 (each instance)	Teacher or Student
Inappropriate language	1-5 (each instance)	Teacher or Student
Equipment being left out after practices/matches	1 (each instance)	Teacher or Student
