<b>School Spirit</b>	Cheer includes basic school spirit with little enthusiasm or creativity.	Cheer shows moderate school spirit but lacks energy or uniqueness. <b>Creativity</b>	Basic and lacks originality or excitement.	Shows some creativity but relies on familiar ideas.	Creative with unique phrases, movements, or props.	Highly creative and Original. Exciting movements and imaginative use of props or themes.
<b>Teamwork</b>	Minimal team involvement; only a few members actively participate.	Most team members participate, but coordination is inconsistent.	All team members participate with good coordination and shared responsibility.	All team members are fully engaged, working together with strong coordination and shared enthusiasm.
